Travel Tour of Carlsbad Caverns, New Mexico Thursday, September 21 1:30pm Library



Walk with us to Carlsbad Caverns, a spectacular cave complex deep underground in New Mexico. These caves are unusual, as they formed from sulfuric acid instead of water erosion. Hydrogen sulfide-rich water rose from the nearby oil reservoirs as early as 12 million years ago and mixed with groundwater to form sulfuric acid. The limestone was dissolved at the water table, and therefore Carlsbad Caverns was dissolved from below and not from above.
