

Also known as the "Festival of Lights,"
Hanukkah is an eight-day Jewish holiday
celebrating the rededication of the Temple
in Jerusalem in the Second Century B.C.
Hanukkah is the Hebrew word for "dedication."

The history of the holiday is tied to the time when Israel was struggling for existence. It is believed that after a successful revolt against a tyrannical monarch, the victorious Jewish community could find very little pure olive oil to light the Menorah, only enough for one day. However, the oil lasted for eight days,






