Monday, September 22nd with 9:00am departure.

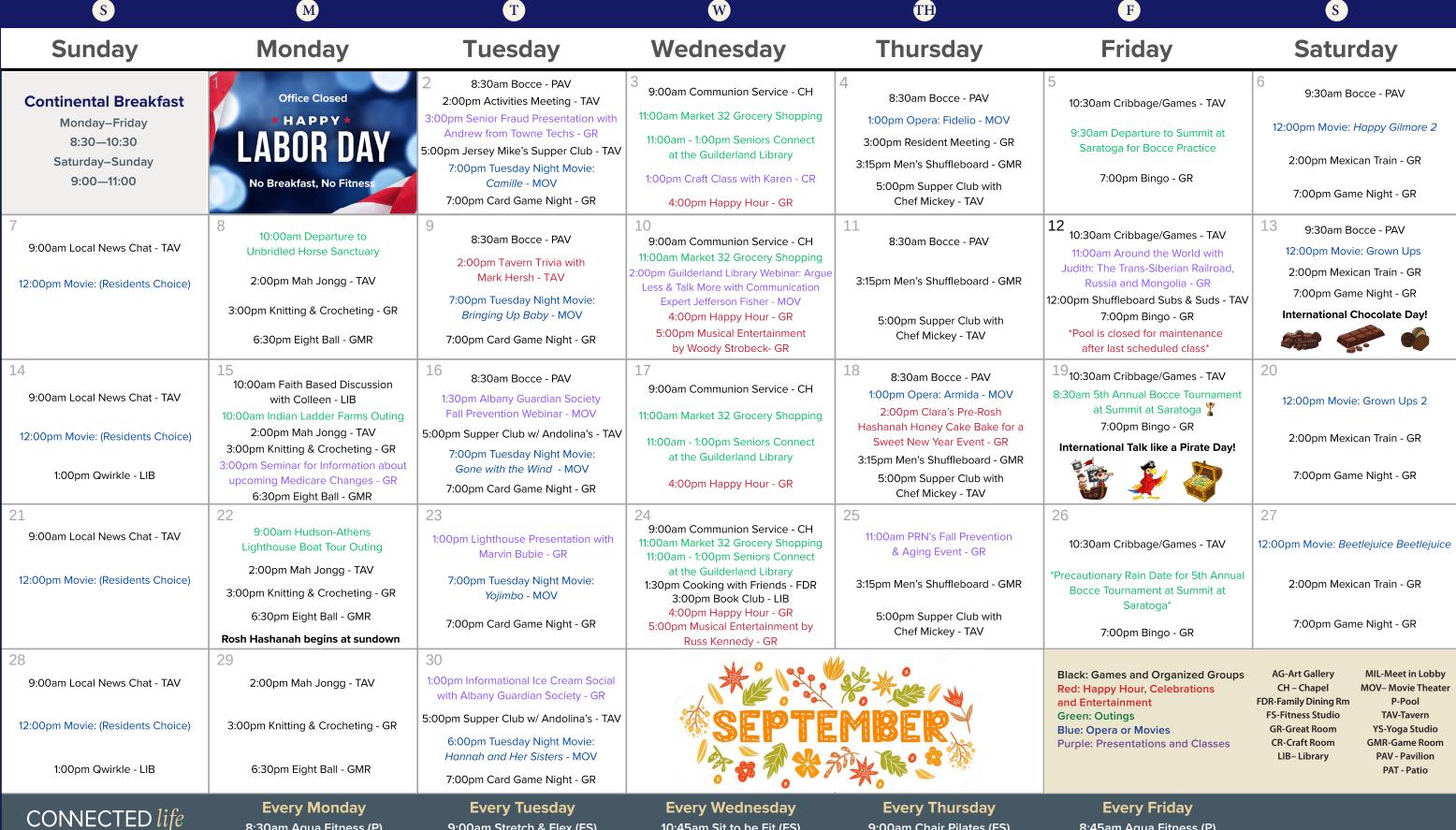
Step aboard with the Hudson-Athens Lighthouse

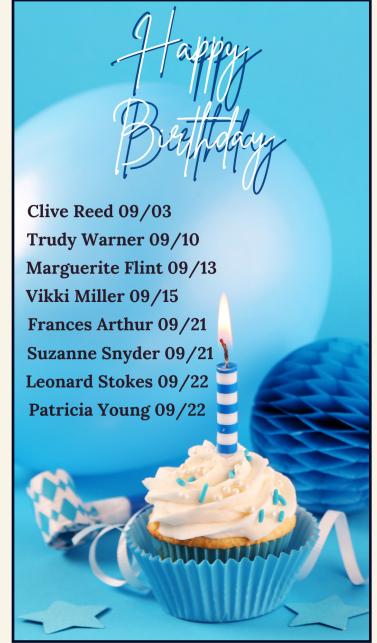

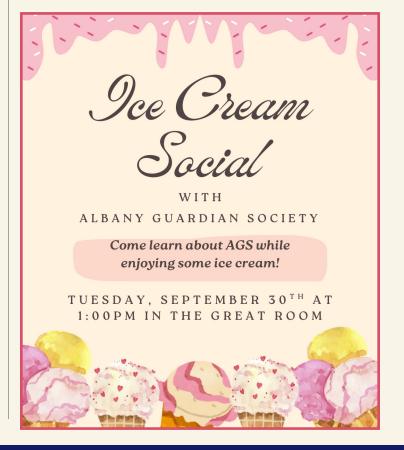
